

Common Tasks on SDMMP website

sdmmp.com

Find a specific report by name or author

Option 1- If you know the exact author (and potentially year)

Go to Resources

Library

Choose an author from the drop down

(Choose year, if known, from drop down)

Click Submit

Option 2- If you don't know the exact title or author but know the topic

Go to MSP Portal

Choose either Species, Vegetation community, or threat

Choose specific topic from the list

Click on Projects tab

Use the search or scroll through the list looking for the project

Click on Files & Documents

Use the search or scroll through the list looking for the report

Sort columns by year or title to narrow the search

Find all reports on a specific species

Go to MSP Portal

Click Species (works also for a vegetation community or threat)

Click Files & Documents

Click on each one to download or read

Find all reports for a specific preserve

Go to MSP Portal

Click Spatial Search

Click on the preserve on the map

Scroll down on the right

Click "Articles associated with this preserve"

Data for a specific species/veg/threat

Option 1- You want raw, complete data from a specific project

- Click MSP Portal

- Choose species, vegetation communities, or threats

- Choose target from the list

- Click Projects

- Click through the projects individually

- Click on "Project Data/Files"

- Download individual files

Option 2- You want a compilation of a species across projects with a subset of information

- Go to Resources

- GIS Map Viewer

- Can filter for an individual species on the left

- Turn on and off layers on the right

- To download as a shapefile, at the top, click "Download Data"

Priority objectives for grant application

- Go to MSP Portal

- Click Track MSP Progress

- Filter for species, vegetation community, and threat (if wanted)

- Under "Status", choose "Available for implementation"

- Click Submit
