However, these activities can have significant effects on wildlife that live in those areas.

- Review papers
- Commentaries or Essays that provide well-argued and well-documented personal perspectives
- Book reviews on recent books that have been published on the topic

- Manuscript submission deadline: September 30, 2019
- Expected publication date: March 2020
